

Utah Youth Rodeo Association

Welcome to the Utah Youth Rodeo Association 2006-2007 Year! Our organization consists of approximately 225 members per year with 15 events in 4 different age groups. Last year a total of over \$18,000.00 was spent on our year-end prizes and \$30,000.00 was handed out in payback checks! Our year-end prizes consisted of 6 saddles, 72 buckles, sculptures and many other prizes.

Point accumulations are earned throughout the year along with the payback checks to the top placing contestants.

The registration fee of \$30.00 or \$15.00 per member and the minimum \$50.00 sponsorship fees are used to run the rodeos, buy office supplies and equipment throughout the year, and to help pay for our yearend prizes. All UYRA Board members are volunteers and donate their time to helping the youth. We are always in need of another helping hand, so if you have an extra one don't feel shy to volunteer!

The entry fees from each rodeo are used to pay for the rodeo fees, which include the STOCKCHARGE, ARENA, ambulance, insurance, announcers, and judges. The remainder of the fee money is paid back to the contestants in payback checks, which are determined according to the following percent breakdown. (Note: the rough stock events get a lower percent payback, because the biggest expense that we pay out is to the stock contractor, for the contestant's various stock events.)

Barrels & Poles	receive	60%
Goat & Calf Tying	receive	45%
5 & under events	receive	50%
Rough Stock & Roping Events	receive	36% PAYBACKS!

We as a board have worked hard to make changes to better our organization for the youth who participate. We appreciate any suggestions and help you may have to offer. We would like to encourage all parents to become involved throughout the year, volunteering your time is essential to making this organization run smoothly. We are in need of timers and raker's. We encourage everyone to do their part, as we really need volunteers in these areas!

BREAKAWAY ROPING: 8-11, 12-14 (Boys & Girls)	\$15.00
CHUTE DOGGIN 12-14 (Boys only) (6 grade boys may enter)	\$15.00
TEAM ROPING, PER MAN	\$15.00
MUTTON' BUSTIN & CALF RIDING (Boys & Girls)	\$15.00
STEER RIDING: 12-14 (Boys Only)	\$15.00
BULL RIDING: 12-14 (Boys Only)	\$25.00

There is an annual, NONREFUNDABLE, registration fee of \$30.00 assessed to join the association. Each member must also solicit a minimum of \$50.00 sponsorship fee. For children only participating in the 5 & under events only, the registration fee is \$15.00 along with a \$50.00 sponsorship fee. **Sponsorship fee's are due by the October Rodeo!** Contestants will not be allowed to sign-up or participate in any future rodeo's until all fees are brought current.

Timed Event & Rough Stock Events Sign-up's will be taken at the Rodeo 1-month prior. To avoid late fee's we strongly encourage all members to take advantage of this sign-up system.

If you are unable to sign up on rodeo nights, calls will be taken by:

Late Fees will be applied at 9:01 p.m.

No sign-up calls will be taken from non-members. New members may join the association between 4:30-5:30 p.m. on rodeo days, one month prior to participating in the rodeo. Finals rodeo sign-ups will be the same for finalists, except that the alternates in the timed events and rough stock must call in. Those finalists failing to sign-up at July rodeo or call in during above said time will lose their slot at the rodeo to the alternates who have signed-up. The alternates will be put in at 9:01 p.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Messages left on voice mail will only be considered valid entries if received from 7:00p.m. To 9:00 p.m. on Sign-Up day! Sign-up Calls will be taken from 7:00-9:00 p.m. **ONLY!** Any calls or voice mail received after 9:00 p.m. will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

There will be a \$5.00 turn out fee in each event that the contestant is signed up for, and does not participate in, unless a 24 hour notice is given to the above said entry numbers, or a vet or doctors excuse is presented. **ENTRIES CLOSE ONE WEEK BEFORE RODEO DATE!**

Rough stock contestants will sign up one-month prior for each of the rodeos, at the prior month's rodeo or during the designated date and time. The contestant will be calling in during the designated date and time to find out if he/she drew out for that particular month's rodeo. You may sign up for the next months draw at that time. If your name is rotated up so that you are up in the event in which you signed up for and you fail to sign-up at the rodeo or call in during the designated date and time, your name will be bumped to the bottom of the rotation list. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** New members will start at the bottom of the list and work up. The rough stock entries that are rotated up in the rodeo will be randomly drawn for position by the computer. All stock will be chute drawn, except bulls they will be a draw. If you re unavailable to sign up or call in on the designated date and time, you will need to make arrangements with someone else to call and sign up for you, **NO early sign-up calls will be taken!**

All rodeos (with the exception of the finals) will start promptly at 5:00 p.m.

All contestants are required to pay fees before participating

All rough stock entries must be paid for by 5:50 p.m.

Alternates will be put in place of the contestants failing to do so,
and a \$5.00 turn out fee will be assessed.
